Our governors have commenced the difficult task of reducing expenditure for our reduced number on roll. It is important to realise that once we have shaped staffing structure and the budget for a 210 place school, future organisation should be much easier! 30 pupils in each year group and pure year group classes will actually help with the delivery of the curriculum. We'll obviously miss the days of having 270+ pupils, but with a lack of new housing in the town, those days are clearly a thing of the past. We have 204 pupils on roll and actually only need more pupils in YR and Y4; the other year groups are very healthy and next year's intake should be a good size too. Affording everything that a bigger school could, is going to be tricky, but hopefully we can continue to have Shropshire Music Service involved beyond this year please see the letter that is coming home with this newsletter.

To highlight what we have achieved in Music, we are now recognised as a Music Mark School, an achievement we wouldn't be able to gain without Mrs Allen-Brown and the Music Service.


Clearly, most of our customers are very happy!

Church Stretton Neighbourhood Plan

An opportunity to design the image of the future

Church Stretton's new Neighbourhood Plan is the next important step in the Town's development. It is designed to deliver the homes which residents have said we need whilst preserving the hills and the countryside around the town which define who we are. The plan will be in place for many <u>years</u>, and is intended to benefit the children of today and help them live and work here in the future.

The first step is to deliver a leaflet to all homes seeking views on the detailed scope of plan, and we want to work with St Lawrence Primary School to involve the children in the creation of this leaflet by designing the front cover.
